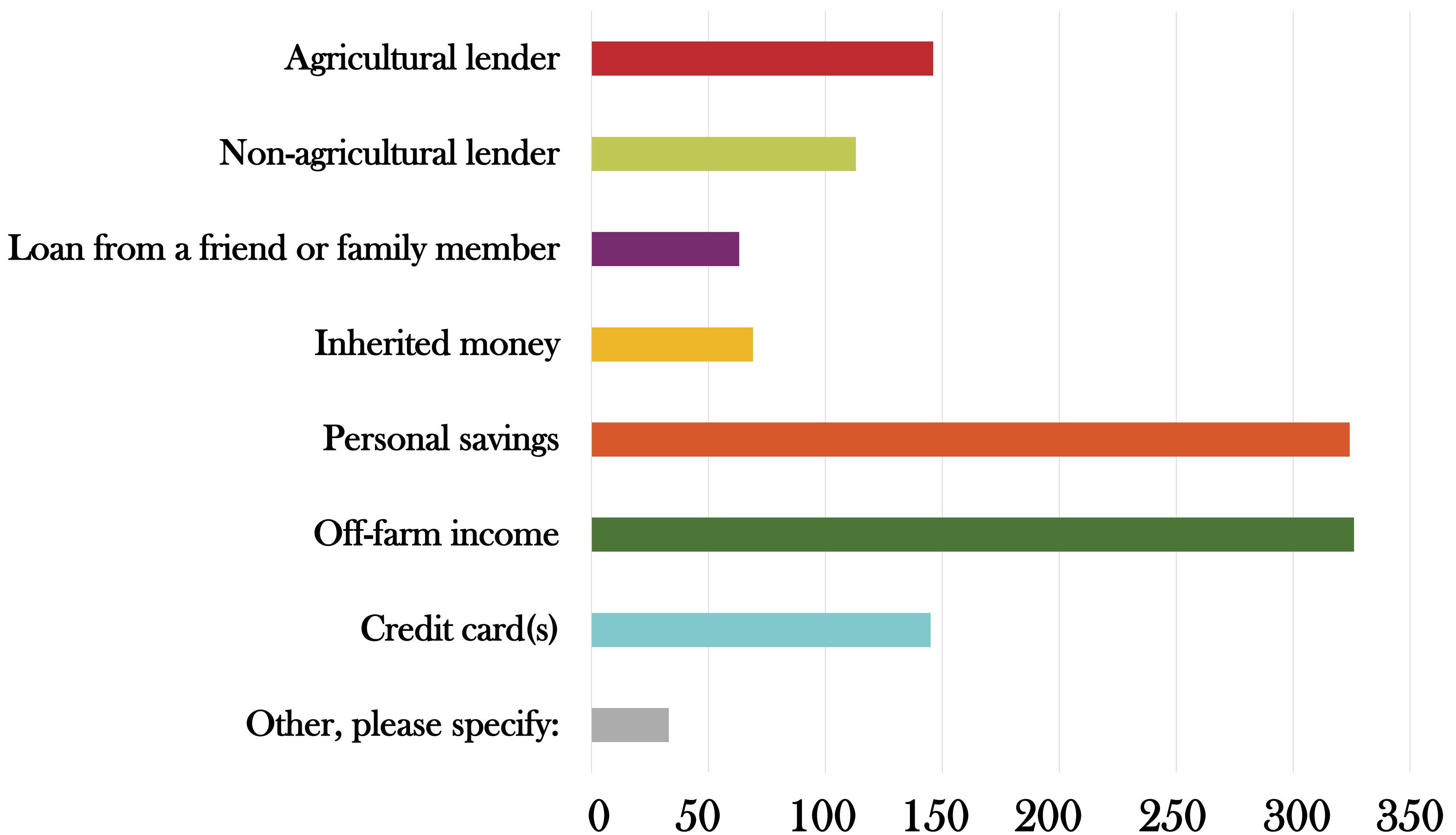


Idaho Women Farmers & Ranchers: Sources of Capital Utilized for Establishing and Operating Farms and Ranches

Women own and operate all sizes and types of farm and ranch operations throughout Idaho. Producers utilize a variety of capital sources to establish and operate their farms and ranches. The most common sources of capital for Idaho's women in agriculture are off-farm income and personal savings. Other sources of capital utilized by producers include ag and non-ag lenders and credit cards.
