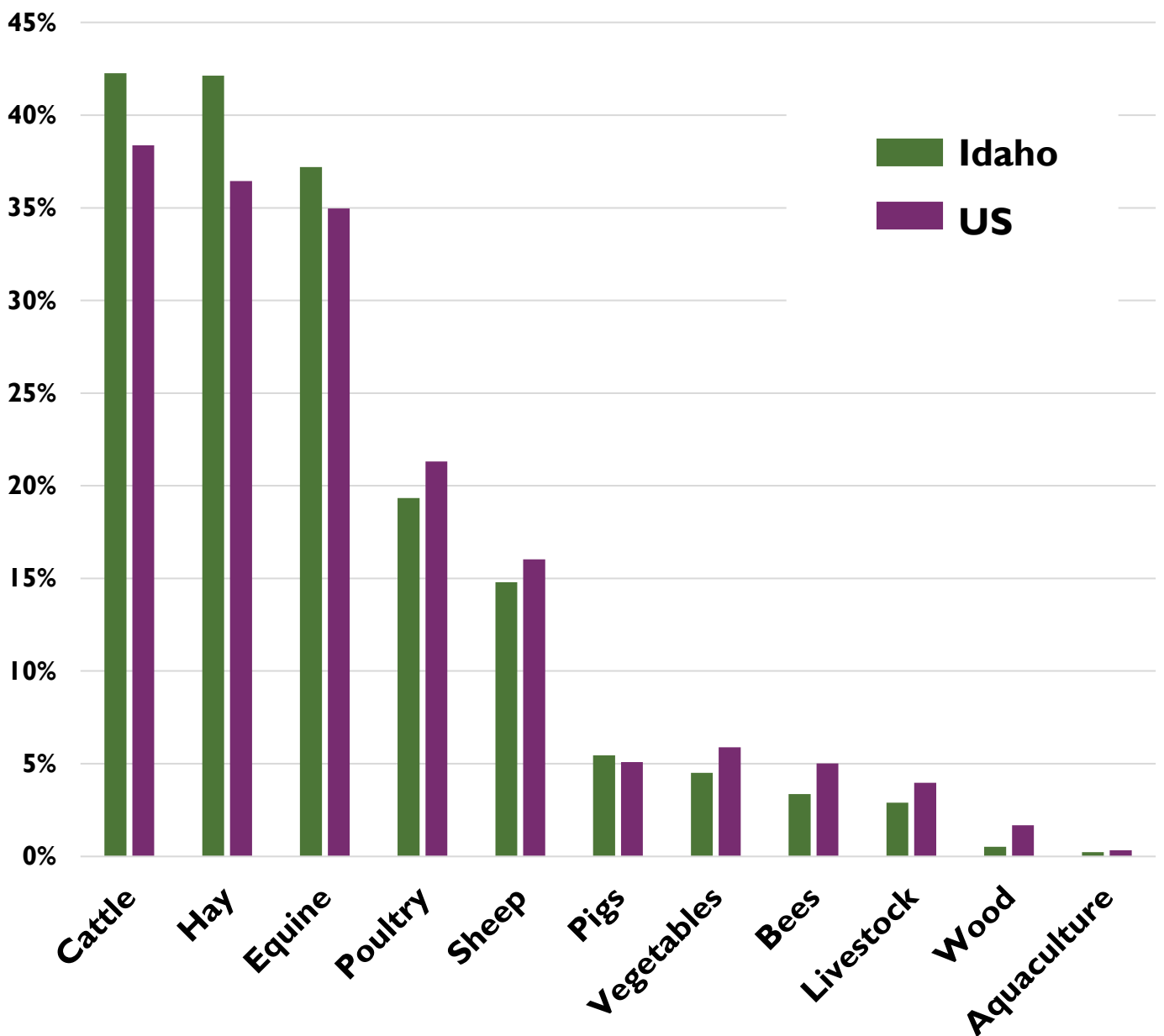


Women Primary Farmers and Ranchers as Percent of the Total for Specific Products in Idaho and the US

In Idaho, women primary farmers and ranchers are responsible for over 42% of the hay and cattle production, but less than 4% of bee production.

Compared to national averages, women in Idaho are more likely to be involved in equine production, but less likely to be responsible for vegetable production than US women on average.



In analyzing the 2017 Census of Agriculture data, our U of I Research Team designated one farmer per farm as the primary producer. The **primary producer** is the farmer who made the most farm decisions and worked the fewest days off farm.
